## **Health & Safety Policy**

1. The organiser has overall responsibility for Health & Safety.
2. The event is organized in accordance with Health & Safety Legislation and all who have (to any extent) control of the showground are responsible for ensuring that:
  - a. Everything reasonably practicable is done to ensure the health & safety and welfare of those attending the show.
  - b. All attendees should conduct themselves so that they do not put themselves or anyone else at risk.
  - c. Entry to and exit from the showground are safe.
- 3a. Emergency services must have access to all parts of the site at all times and members of the public must not park vehicles so as to obstruct access.
- 3b. The First Aid will be clearly signed.
- 3c. In the case of emergency, members of the public should contact the nearest official or dial 999.
4. Horses are easily frightened and can be dangerous. Members of the public are requested to keep clear from horse areas and to avoid behaviour which might alarm horses. Dogs **MUST** be kept on leads and under control at all times.
5. Small children must be kept under close supervision.

# Conditions of Entry

- a) No claims will be entertained for anything which may happen to competitors, their servants, onlookers, horses, vehicles or property in connection with, or arising from the Show and it shall be a condition of entry that each entrant shall indemnify the Committee and owners of the property, against any legal action arising from any mishap.
- b) The Judges' decision is final in all events.
- c) All jumping classes according to BSA rules.
- d) All dressage classes according to BD rules.
- e) No spurs to be worn in Class 7, 8, 17 and 18.
- f) Dogs **MUST** be on leads and under close control at all times.
- g) **Everyone mounted, whether a competitor or not, must wear protective headgear conforming to PAS 015, BSEN 1384, ASTMF 1163 standard SNEL, which includes a permanently fitted, non-detachable retaining harness, secured to the shell at more than two points. Such headgear must be worn properly secured.**
- h) Suitable riding attire must be worn at all times. Body protectors and crash caps with black, dark blue, dark green or brown silks are acceptable in **all** classes. Fawn, cream or white jodhpurs/breeches in all classes.
- i) The Committee reserves the right to refuse or reject any entry and to withdraw or amend any of the prizes offered and to cancel any class at their discretion.
- j) **Riders are required to ride sensibly at all times and horses must use the walkways and areas designated for them. NO GALLOPING.**
- k) Any queries or complaints must be written and handed to the show secretary within 15 minutes of the incident, accompanied by a fee of £20 which will be refunded if the objection is upheld.
- l) No entry fee will be refunded unless a class is cancelled or a Veterinary Certificate / Doctor's Certificate is produced no later than 16th June 2010.
- m) **Winners of all Cups at the 2010 Show will be required to sign an undertaking to keep them in safe custody and return them undamaged and engraved by 1st May 2011 or to replace it with a new one. A refundable deposit of £25 will be required before cups are released to winners.**
- n) Any person allowing their vehicle to be towed does so at their own risk.
- o) Horses passports will not be checked by the organisers but you are reminded that you are required by law to carry these when travelling horses/ponies.
