Great timing to have a practice over a very inviting course, especially if you plan on entering Pacheshams One Day Event, Hunter Trials or Eventers Challenge at the end of May or beginning of June. The Instructor: Kajsa Mansby Svedberg (https://www.facebook.com/kajsamseventing) Kajsa is a professional 4* event rider from Sweden. She attended the Swedish University of Agricultural Sciences where she qualified as a veterinary nurse before she came over to England in 2016 to pursue her passion for eventing.

Kajsa began her career in the UK working for Sir Mark Todd before basing with Kevin and Emma McNab. Having the opportunity to work alongside these great professionals in the sport has given Kajsa a huge amount of knowledge and experience that she now uses in her everyday work. Kajsa competed at Le Lion young horse World Championships, Blenheim Palace and got podium placing with the Swedish team in Nations Cup.

She is fortunate to have been supported by the Swedish Federation's project ATG Ridsport and mentored by former British Equestrian team coach Yogi Breisner.

A word from Team Manager - Marci Teams and Competitions Update

We've had lots of people out competing over the last month and some more great results:

Our members Chloe Martin, Sandra Hewitt, Nadia diLuzio, Bex Harris, Helen Francis and Emma Bishop competed at the Intermediate Winter Dressage National Qualifier at Sands Farm, getting a 7th team place against some tough competition. Individually Chloe Martin won the P18 on a massive 73.27% and Bex Harris came 5th in the E42.

Helen Francis and Gasper travelled to Arena UK and came a fantastic 7th in the National FINAL of the Novice Winter Dressage Championships.

Then we had the Area 11 Friendly Dressage at Merrist Wood, where CDRC members turned out in force! We put forward 4 teams plus 4 individuals - 16 members altogether so it felt very much like a club outing! Our winning teams were the Chobham Charmers - 2nd (Fran Milnes, Chloe Martin and Lily Bowen) and the Chobham Chasers 6th (Megs Michaels, Samantha Dean and Lola Rega). Individual top 3 placings were Moya Payne 1st in N27, 2nds for Lola, Fran and Chloe and 3rd for Lily.

Last up was the Combined Training (Dressage and SJ) National Qualifier at Felbridge. Sarah Miller, Stacey Bishopp and Alice Scott all competed individually in different sections and each came 2nd in their section - another fantastic result for CDRC.

Future Dates

The next BIG date is of course our CDRC dressage show on 14 May 2023 at Merrist Wood. This is open to all, R/C and non R/C members and so I will not be responsible for putting teams together. So grab your friends, make up a team of 3, think of a team name and get entering! However, if you would like to be in a team, but don't have anyone to team up with, then I will be happy to act as a liaison point and put people in touch with each other. All classes can also be entered as an individual only and there are classes for everyone.

Looking forward to the summer we have qualifiers for Style and SJ at Elstead on 1 July, Dressage to Music on 9 July at Belmoredean, Dressage and Riding Test at Pachesham on 16 July and Intro Dressage at Priory on 13 August. Please have a look at these dates now and let me know if you are interested so we can start to think about entries nice and early. Please note that unfortunately the Dressage and Riding Test Competition at Pachesham now clashes with our new camp date.
