Alice Beach ride

A few people have been asking about beach riding so here is some information to hopefully cover most things!

I normally go to Hayling Island Beach, it's the nearest to me and the biggest. You want to go when the tide is low as then you can get onto a massive sandbank that is great for riding on (and because it's so big it is easy to find your own space there even if the main beach is busy). There is a reasonable sized car park but it's not as big as it used to be. Go down the A3 for ages! Then Hayling Island is well sign posted, you want the West Beach which is right at the bottom of the island.

You are only allowed to ride on the beach until 10am and then after 7pm, this used to be only in the summer but recently the rules have changed so it applies all year round :(You have to pay to park, around £16 for a car and trailer! However, parking charges only apply after 9am so if you are super early you can park for free. There are loos at this car park and also a small shop selling ice creams, food, drink etc.

Ideally you want the lowest tide to be between 8am and 9.30am (unless you are happy to be there really really early!). Be a bit careful if you go out onto the big sandbank that you don't get cut off by the tide coming back in as it covers the bank nearest the shore first so be aware of what the tide is doing! If you Google 'Hayling Island Tide Times' lots of

sites come up, I normally use 'Willy Weather' https://tides.willyweather.co.uk/se/ham pshire/hayling-island-west-beach.html As you can check the tides far into the future (a lot of the sites only let you look 5 days ahead).
