#### National lockdown

Following the recent announcement of another national lockdown in England from Thursday 5 November until Wednesday 2 December, we are saddened to announce that the current interpretation is that all BRC activity, bar virtual activity, must cease during this time. For the avoidance of doubt, this includes all activities run under the BRC banner, including competitions, training, clinics and camps.

We understand that this is a huge disappointment and many members had already committed to take part in the upcoming training. Unfortunately, this does mean these events are all cancelled. If you had paid entry already, please email us with your full account details for us to process the refunds.

#### Lockdown the rules

- Exercise outdoors is permitted and this includes horse riding. This can be undertaken with the people who you live with, your support bubble or one other person
- You can travel for exercise if you need to make a short journey to do so
- You are permitted to leave your home to care or exercise an animal or horse where they are not kept at home
- You can leave home to seek advice about the health or welfare of your horse including veterinary, farriery, dentistry and physiotherapy treatments
- Farriery, veterinary and physiotherapy treatments can continue
- When visiting a livery yard or stables you should avoid unnecessary social contact and gathering with people who you do not live with
- You should follow the Covid protocols which are in place and maintain social distancing
- You should not visit a livery yard if you have coronavirus symptoms, are awaiting a test result, if you live with anyone who is exhibiting symptoms or who has tested positive or if you have been notified to selfisolate via Track and Trace

Hello,

Are you perfectly balanced and symmetrical when you ride?

Here are some simple alignment checks you can do yourself:

- Sitting in the saddle, is the zip of your breeches vertical?
- Is there an equal amount of saddle leather visible on both sides?
- Are the buttons/zip on your top aligned vertically?
- And are they in line with your breeches' zip and the centre of the pommel?
- Can you see more of one side of the horse than the other?
- Is the wear/dirt on the inside of your boots the same on both sides?
- Look at a pair of shoes you wear a lot. Is the wear pattern the same on both? Look particularly at the heels.

No cheating! 'Fix' yourself into position *before* carrying out these checks. They should give you some clues as to how to correct and perfect your position.

Hope you are able to enjoy time with your horses during lockdown.
