

Rules

1. No claim will be entertained for anything that may happen to competitors, spectators, their property, servants, horses or ponies in connection with or arising from this competition. Admission is granted and entries accepted only upon this condition. It shall be considered a condition of entry that each entrant shall agree to indemnify the organisers against any legal action arising there from.
2. The organisers reserve the right to reject or cancel any entry or entries and to cancel any class or classes (refunding any fees paid). Under normal circumstances, fees will not be refunded unless a vet's or doctor's certificate is produced. An administrative cost of £2 per class will be retained by the organiser.
3. The decision of the judges and show officials is, in every case, to be accepted as final
4. All riders to be correctly dressed and hard hats (PAS015 or BSEN1384) to be worn when mounted with chin straps fastened.
5. Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times
6. Horses when not competing must be kept strictly to the horse lines, collecting enclosures and exercising paddocks - animals must not be tied to any of the fences. Competitors are asked to co-operate for the safety of all concerned. Please take your litter home.
7. Should the event be cancelled £2.00 per horse entered will be retained for administration costs
8. No ridden horses under 4 years.
9. Riding Club Dressage Rules will apply.
10. Health and Safety. The organiser of this event has taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organiser and all the officials and stewards
11. The event photographer will be easily identifiable.
12. Your horse's passports may be required to be seen by the secretary, so please bring it with you. It is also an offence to travel your horse without one.
13. Any complaints are to be submitted to the organiser in writing with a deposit of £20.
14. Spaces will be limited and will be allocated on date of receipt of entry and payment
15. The organiser has the right to refuse entry if any horse welfare is compromised
16. Current Gov COVID regulations must be followed or as directed by officials

Select any of the tests below and state which test in class notes when entering. Example 'Novice 27'

Intro B (2009) Walk & Trot

Neither Horse nor rider to have any BD points

Prelim 14 (2006)

Neither Horse nor rider to have any BD points

Prelim 18 (2002)

Neither Horse nor rider to have any BD points at Novice+

Novice 27 (2007)

Neither Horse nor rider to have any BD points at Elem+

Class 2 - Combined training—Pick your own

Combined Training consists of two phases, Dressage and Show Jumping. The same horse and rider must complete both phases

The dressage score is calculated to give a score of penalty points. The show jumping penalties, including time faults are then added to create a final score.

- Step 1 – Enter class 2
- Step 2 - Enter the dressage test to be ridden, adding CT as a comment in the class notes. Example 'CT Prelim 14'.
- Step 3 - Enter the show jumping class to be jumped, adding CT as a comment in the class notes. Example 'CT'

You will then be entered in **both** of the standalone competitions **plus** the combined training as a bonus class

Arena 3— In Hand - £12 per class

10:00 - Class 31 – In hand Veterans 17+

Horses must be 17 years old or over

Class 32 – In hand Mountain and Moorland

Class 33 – In hand Cobs

Class 34 – In hand Coloureds

13:00 - Class 35 - Prettiest Mare

Class 36 - Handsomest Gelding

Class 37 – Best mane and tail

Arena 4— Clear Round - £3 per round

09:00 – Class 40 - All day clear round

Height will be increased in line with the jumping classes

Arena 5 — Show Jumping/Riding Club challenge - £12 per round

The Riding Club Challenge (applied to classes 53, 55 and 58) is a test of the ability of a pony/ horse and rider to negotiate a show jumping course together with a variety of portable cross-country style fences with a Joker fence which will be the final fence in the course and be measured 10cm above the class height. Jumping penalties will be incurred for faults, including time penalties.

09:00 - Class 51 - True Beginners Jumping

Jumps approximately 40cm.

Class 52 - Beginners Jumping

Jumps approximately 60cm.

Class 53 - Beginners challenge

Jumps approximately 60cm.

Class 54 - Novice Jumping

Jumps approximately 70cm.

Class 55 - Novice challenge

Jumps approximately 70cm

Class 56- 75cm Open Jumping

Jumps approximately 75cm in 1st round

Class 57 - 80cm Open Jumping

Jumps approximately 80cm in 1st round.

Class 58 – 80cm Open challenge

Jumps approximately 80cm.

Class 59 - 85cm Open Jumping

Jumps approximately 85cm in 1st round.

Arena 2— Ridden Showing - £12 per class

10:00 Class 20 - Ridden Lead Rein

Riders must be 8 years old or under and may not enter class 21

Class 21 - First Ridden

Riders must be 12 years old or under and may not enter class 20

Class 22 – Best Junior Ridden

Riders must be 18 years old or under and may not enter class 21

Class 23 - Ridden Veterans 17+

Horses must be 17 years old or over

13:00 Class 24 – Ridden Mountain and Moorland

Class 25 – Ridden Cobs

Class 26 – Ridden Coloureds

Class 27 - Riding Club Pony 14.2 and under, rider any age

To be judged on suitability for all Riding Club disciplines. Will be expected to jump not exceeding 70cm.

Class 28 - Riding Club Horse exceeding 14.2, rider any age

To be judged on suitability for all Riding Club disciplines. Will be expected to jump not exceeding 80cm.

Class 29 - ROR—Retrained Racehorse

To be eligible your horse must have raced in Great Britain and have an RoR number.
